Footnotes

EL GATO MALO pressed the pace between horses down the backstretch, remained between foes around the second turn, took command and drew clear through the final furlong. SANDOR (GB) chased on the inside down the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn, steadied behind horses on the inside at the quarter pole, came out for the stretch drive, angled inside the leaders late and gained the place on the wire. POSSE POWER was caught three wide around the first turn and into the backstretch, bid three wide to the stretch, could not keep pace with the winner and was edged for the place at the wire. DR. SMARTY JACK pulled hard and steadied sharply entering the first turn, chased on the outside down the backstretch, steadied again into the second turn, continued three wide and did not offer the necessary rally in the stretch drive. FANTASTIC PICK (GB) stalked a bit off the rail down the backstretch and between foes on the second turn and weakened when asked in the final furlong. LIFE IS A ROCK was hustled to the lead into the first turn, showed the way on the inside to the quarter pole and weakened on the wood through the final furlong.
