BRIECAT chased inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch, bid inside the runner-up to gain a slim lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. GIVINE (FR) prompted the pace four wide then stalked outside a rival leaving the backstretch, re-bid three deep on the turn, was floated out some into the stretch, took a short lead in upper stretch, inched away in midstretch, fought back outside the winner in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. A JEALOUS WOMAN pressed the pace three deep between foes then stalked leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn, bid along the fence in the stretch and bested the others. RARE SUNSET had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. BELLA DIAMANTE dropped back off the rail then angled in some on the backstretch, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. ELLE SPECIAL settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HOME SWEET ASPEN dueled between horses then outside a rival, battled between foes on the turn, was floated out a bit into the stretch and weakened.
