Footnotes

CORTINA chased outside on the backstretch, advanced three deep then four wide on the turn, bid alongside the leader into the stretch, gained the advantage in upper stretch and pulled clear under urging. TUCKED AWAY stalked between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the bend, came out in upper stretch and finished well. CHAMP'S OLE' tracked the leader three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, continued outside a rival then a bit off the rail into the stretch and bested the rest. PERFECTINEVERYWAY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, opened up on the turn but weakened in the stretch. DOTTED SWISS chased between horses then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and did not rally. SUMMER SPECIAL allowed to settle outside on the backstretch, went four wide on the turn and failed to menace. FREQUENT MEETING off a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace, steadied nearing the quarter pole when in a bit tight and weakened. DISCOVER A GEM settled a bit off the rail, found the fence on the turn, came out into the stretch and was not a factor.
