Footnotes

FRANGIPANNI stalked the pace inside on the backstretch and turn then rallied along the rail under urging to get up late. PERFECT QUALITY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and held on well but was caught between foes late. PEGASUS LADY stalked three deep then outside a rival on the turn and into the stretch and continued on well to hold the show. MISS COZY CAT pulled under a hold off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, came out past midstretch and finished willingly. SOOTHING TOUCH chased between horses then outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, drifted out and lacked the needed rally. CITY HEAT chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch, came out and could not offer the necessary response. TOPAZ MOON settled off the rail chasing the pace, went between horses on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. STOP THE HUMOR stalked between horses then a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. GRAND DREAM stalked the pace outside then four wide on the turn and into the stretch and also weakened.
