AMAZINGLY had good early speed and dueled inside, kicked clear under left handed urging in the stretch and held gamely. PEPPY BOLLY a bit slow to begin, saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail in midstretch and finished willingly. SPRING BLOOM chased a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out slightly in deep stretch and also went on well to the end. ZANBO unhurried and angled in a bit off the rail to the stretch, came out in midstretch and found her best stride late. SASSY AND SINGLE broke a bit slowly and steadied, settled a bit off the fence, swung out in upper stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. SALAH'S DANCER stalked outside a rival, came out some in the stretch, split horses in deep stretch, angled in and lacked the necessary rally. PASTORIA a bit slow into stride, was close up stalking the winner a bit off the rail, continued alongside a rival into the stretch and weakened. GYPSY FRIDAY forced the pace outside the winner to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CAJUN MARKET broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then angled in, saved ground on the turn and in the stretch and was not a factor. YA WANNA HUG four wide early, chased three deep then outside a rival into the stretch and weakened.
