TA TA BE TRUE, pulled inside early, stalked the pace a bit off the rail, took the lead outside the pacesetter and inched away on the second turn and held sway under urging. AFFIRMED MISS, saved ground tracking the leader, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well for second. LAZY SLUSAN, unhurried early, went three deep on the backstretch, angled in for the second turn, came around a rival into the stretch, came off the rail in deep stretch and just got third. DUSTY HEATHER, angled in and saved ground off the pace, also came around a rival into the stretch, drifted out slightly in midstretch and was caught late for the show. SPEAKING OF TIME, broke awkwardly, saved ground until nearing the stretch, came out and put in a late bid. FINALLY (AUS), three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail, loomed a threat behind the winner into the stretch but weakened. MILLBRAE, threw her head in an awkward start, was outrun off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SKYWARD MELODY, settled off the inside, was three deep into the stretch, was a bit crowded in midstretch but lacked a rally. LOMA LINDA LASS, sped to the early lead outside the winner, inched clear and angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside but had little left once headed.
