MARQUET REBEL three wide between horses early, chased four wide between foes then angled in leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the second

turn, went around a rival into the stretch, bid inside in the drive, gained the lead past the eighth pole and pulled clear under some urging and steady handling. ZOHAN chased between rivals then outside a foe, angled in leaving the backstretch, bid alongside a rival to gain the lead on the second turn, fought back outside the winner in the stretch and was second best. FORTUNATE VICTORY four wide into the first turn, went up five wide on the backstretch, continued four wide on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, drifted in some and held third. SILVERADO GOLD chased between horses then off the rail on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and just missed the show. ROAD TO THE THRONE unhurried off the rail early, moved up outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, split rivals in the drive and improved position. CORKYNPHILYS FLYER a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, dropped back on the second turn, waited then split horses in midstretch and lacked a further response. WARREN'S ALLSTAR four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. DAILY SUDS chased between horses, came three wide into the stretch and did not rally. BARACHO five wide into the first turn, pulled his way to the front outside a rival, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. A PINT FOR MARY a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then inside and failed to menace. TUMBLING DICE MAN sent inside then pulled his way along off the rail to force then stalk the pace, steadied sharply between horses into the second turn, dropped back and gave way.
