ALEC'S MOON chased inside, came out early on the turn then was forced out midway on the bend, came a bit wide into the stretch and rallied under some urging and good handling to wear down the runner-up late. TERODA was in a good position chasing the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, took the lead alongside a rival in midstretch, inched away just off the fence and held well to late stretch but could not contain the winner late. BELLEOFTHEBRIDLE sent along inside to stalk the pace, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. SUGARINTHEMORNING stalked the early pace then went up three deep early on the turn, dueled outside a rival on a short lead, battled inside the runner-up in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong. LUCKY TRIPPI stalked outside a rival then angled in on the turn and bid inside, dueled for the lead, dropped back in the stretch and weakened. FARALLON sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes while being pulled up on the turn and was vanned off.
