Footnotes

IMPONENTE PURSE (BRZ) four wide early, angled in and chased inside, split horses on the final turn, bid alongside the runner-up past midstretch and wore down that rival late under left handed urging. NO DREAM stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid alongside a rival leaving the backstretch, took the lead on the last turn, inched away, drifted out in the stretch, fought back to the wire but could not hold off the winner. INTERPATATION bumped between horses at the start, stalked inside then off the rail, went three deep on the final turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and picked up the show. DYNAMIC RANGE broke out and bumped a rival, stalked inside then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the last turn, angled to the inside entering the stretch and weakened. OLYMPIC CHIEF broke out a bit and bumped a rival, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside, dueled leaving the backstretch and into the last turn, came out some into the stretch and had little left in the drive. BALLETT WAY chased three deep then outside a rival, dropped back off the inside leaving the backstretch and gave way.
