FRUMIOUS had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, inched away on the turn, found the rail in the stretch and drew clear under some left handed urging. SCOFIELD BARRACKS settled off the rail then a bit off the fence, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and gained the place. SEA RASCAL settled outside then alongside a rival, angled in on the turn, came out in the stretch, split horses a sixteenth out and again at the wire to get up for third. VALKYRIE MISSILE broke out slightly, chased a bit off the rail to the stretch and was edged for the show. LT. HOPEFUL dueled inside, stalked the winner along the rail on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. EL MARTILLO chased three deep then outside a rival, continued off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in some on the turn and did not rally. CIRCLE DRIVE stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and weakened.
