ZIPPIN E pulled her way to the lead in the run to the first turn, maintained the advantage along the inside down the backstretch, opened up a commanding advantage on the second turn, was under a drive in midstretch and taken in hand in the final yards. ELLIE L. chased from the back down the backstretch, moved closer on the second turn, came outside for the stretch drive and gained the place in the final yards. BINKY'S SISTER was content to stalk ZIPPIN E around the first turn, remained closest to the latter down the backstretch, began to lose touch with the winner on the second turn but just failed to hold the place in the late stages. SIMPLY PUT chased the pace between horses around the first turn, remained off the rail down the backstretch, was between horses in the final furlong and lacked the necessary rally. SAMBISTA chased three wide around the first turn and outside a rival down the backstretch, was asked for run entering the second turn and gave way through the drive. VICTORY STAND angled over to chase on the rail around the first turn, remained on the inside to the lane and failed to make a bid.
