FIRE IN THE WIND prompted the pace three deep then stalked into the turn, came out midway on the turn and three deep into the stretch, re-bid three wide in midstretch, gained the lead and drifted in a bit under right handed urging past midstretch and proved best. BIG BAD BOO dueled between horses then inside on the turn, inched away into the stretch, fought back and drifted out a bit under left handed pressure nearing the sixteenth pole and held second. WARREN'S DOVE had good early speed and dueled three deep then outside a rival on the turn, fell back a bit into the stretch, steadied in tight between the top pair nearing the sixteenth pole and saved the show. PURSE LUVA a half step slow into stride, chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for third. BOSTON BAKED BEAN steadied nearing the five eighths pole, saved ground chasing the pace, came out some in the stretch and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the run past midstretch among the top three runners but made no change when they ruled the incident did not alter the original order of finish.
