### Footnotes

INDIARA chased inside a rival down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, angled out at the top of the stretch, took command approaching the sixteenth marker and drew clear to the wire. SHE'S VERY RARE chased the pace outside the winner down the backstretch, moved closer on the turn, came into the stretch three wide, rallied on the outside in the final furlong and gained the place in the late stages. FOLK DANCER sped to a clear early lead, showed the way to midstretch, went willingly to the wire and lost the place in the final yards. DISH THE DIRT was unhurried and chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, angled to the rail to save ground around the turn, came off the rail in midstretch and was between foes in the late going. PERFECT FINISH threw her head at the start, angled out leaving the chute, stalked just off the rail to the lane and weakened between foes through the final furlong. SCENT OF CHRISM chased off the rail down the backstretch and outside a foe around the turn and gave way.
