BLING CHA BLING sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, angled in on the turn, continued inside on a clear advantage in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. AMERICAN ACT angled in and stalked just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and was clearly second best. J MAN wide early, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch and just got the show three deep on the line. SMOKING G had speed outside the winner then stalked off the rail or outside a rival leaving the turn, came out some in the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and was edged for third between foes late. MON COEUR stalked off the rail then inside, inched forward along the fence leaving the turn, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened but was outfinished for a minor award late. POWER FOOT saved ground off the pace, came out past midstretch and was not a threat. JANERO hesitated to be away behind the field, settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival on the turn and did not rally. TAX CUT unhurried a bit off the rail to the stretch, failed to menace. LOVE SIR PAUL broke behind the field, settled just off the rail without early speed, dropped far back and was always outrun.
