TACTICAL CAT was unhurried off the rail, began to advance on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down PRIME TIMBER late. PRIME TIMBER saved ground tracking the leaders, came out into the stretch, collared PREMIER PROPERTY just past midstretch, inched away but could not hold off the winner. PREMIER PROPERTY sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, kicked clear on the second turn but weakened in the stretch, then broke down just past the wire. BUCK TROUT, four wide into the first turn, prompted the pace outside PREMIER PROPERTY to the second turn, then weakened. SELECT FEW settled off the inside, angled in approaching the second turn and was never a threat.
