Footnotes

LORD FHAZIO in a bit tight into the first turn, settled three deep, came four wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to prove best. FEBRUARY STORM stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn, took a short lead between horses, lugged in a bit in midstretch, could not match the winner late but fought back for the place. MAYOR MURPHY sped to the early lead, set the pace outside a rival or off the rail, fought back inside when headed, regained a narrow advantage past midstretch, also could not match the winner and was edged for second. PRAIRIE PREDATOR pulled a bit early, chased between horses, moved up between rivals on the second turn, came out some for the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. OKII ARASHI chased the leaders three deep, launched a bid four wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch and was outfinished. MANONTHEMOVE saved ground off the pace, dropped back into the second turn, came out on that bend and wide into the stretch and had a mild late bid. LEPRECHAUN KID forced or stalked the pace along the inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. BENDEROSA saved ground stalking the pace, fell back some on the second turn and also weakened.
