INFORMED sped to the early lead, dueled inside then stalked along the rail, re-bid from the fence into the second turn to regain the lead, inched away in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. GREGORIAN BAY three deep into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, advanced along the fence on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. LIMESTONE EDGE stalked the pace outside or alongside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and bested the others. BAD BOY in a bit tight off heels nearing the first turn, angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and weakened. TIME TO GET EVEN between foes early, chased outside then off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. AUTISM AWARENESS pulled hard pressing the pace, took the lead on the backstretch and inched away, dueled between foes on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BELO PURSE (BRZ) pulled early, chased a bit off the rail then between foes on the backstretch, angled in on the second turn and also weakened.
