ROBIE THE CAT broke on top, angled over leaving the chute, maintained a clear advantage to the stretch and drew out in the final furlong. VALUATION (IRE) stalked the pace on the inside leaving the chute, moved closer down the backstretch, angled outside for the drive and was no match for the winner but was a clear second. WARREN'S A LEGEND broke inward at the start, stalked on the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, could not make a bid in the final furlong but held the show. KING OF THE CREEK chased outside a rival down the backstretch, came into the stretch between horses and was edged for the show on the wire. SMART HOMBRE was off slowly and steadied when squeezed at the start, chased from the back to the lane, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch drive and improved his position. DIXIELAND BLUES was bumped at the start, chased outside a foe down the backstretch, came into the stretch three wide and lacked the necessary rally. PANTHER'S CLAW was rank to place and steadied between horses leaving the chute, chased inside to the lane, steadied again at the furlong marker, angled outside and could not gain the necessary ground. QUITE AN HONOUR chased the pace inside a rival down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and made no impact in the lane.
