Footnotes

SERRA SONG pulled inside then bore out into the first turn, angled in and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch, came a bit off the rail and held under urging. GOOD REQUEST forced wide into the first turn, angled in and chased off the rail, found the fence on the second turn, came out onto a rival in midstretch, then was second best inside. GANDOLF chased between horses then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and bested the others. CLASSIC ATTIRE saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was unfinished. HOLD YOUR GROUND pulled his way along inside then came out leaving the first turn, bid between horses then outside the winner on the second turn, steadied in tight between foes in midstretch and weakened. BEARING POINT three deep on the first turn, chased outside a rival then off the rail, angled in on the second turn and did not rally. SOUTHERN MAN forced wide into the first turn, chased outside, continued off the rail on the second turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and weakened. ORIENTATE SLEW forced six wide into the first turn, angled in and bid three deep on the backstretch to duel for the lead, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
