Footnotes

ABSOLUTE COURAGE stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, bid alongside the runner-up in midstretch, gained the lead and won clear under left handed urging. DEWEY'S SPECIAL pulled his way four wide into the first turn, duelled three deep then outside a rival on the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, could not match the winner but held second. HUNTER CREEK chased off the rail then outside, went three deep on the second turn and into

the stretch and picked up the show. MOSEL had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. YANKEE GEORGE pulled early, angled in and chased inside, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. RUUD BOY pulled his way three deep into the first turn, angled in and chased inside and lacked a late response. THUNDER ALLIANCE settled off the pace inside, came out on the second turn and into the stretch and was not a threat. JOLYMPIO chased between horses, came three deep into the stretch weakened. PACK YOUR BAGS pulled hard under a hold and bid between horses then steadied into the backstretch, dueled between foes, dropped back into the second turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and weakened. BEAN WHO settled off the pace away from the inside, came a bit wide into the stretch and failed to menace. D' WEATHERMAN broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail and was not a factor. CUT five wide into the first turn, chased outside then off the rail, dropped back and angled in some on the second turn, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
