**Footnotes**

GLOW GIRL GO a bit slow to begin, moved up between horses then stalked three deep or off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter leaving the turn, gained the advantage three deep into the stretch, turned back the bid of the runner-up in the final furlong and proved best under some left handed urging and strong handling. PLAY NINE chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside the winner in the drive but could not match that one in the final furlong. MOON MOMENT chased between horses then a bit off the rail, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. WARRENSMYSTERYDICE stalked the pace inside, remained along the rail in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. TOP ROCKETTE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled inside the winner leaving the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. OCTOBERFEST chased off the rail then between foes, angled to the inside on the turn, was in a bit tight off heels into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MA BARKER stalked the pace between horses or a bit off the rail and weakened in the stretch. SANTI'S GIRL broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. MONICA'S EDGE chased outside then three deep, continued off the rail on the turn, found the inside in the stretch and lacked a further response.
