Footnotes

FRANK AND THE GOAT had good early speed and dueled between horses, inched away and angled in on the turn, came a bit off the rail and exchanged bumps with the runner-up in the stretch, responded when headed and fought back inside under late urging to prevail. ONE HOT TOPPER prompted the pace three deep then stalked off the rail, bid again alongside the winner leaving the turn, put a head in front in midstretch and exchanged bumps with that one in the final furlong and was outgamed. VEECU chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and bested the rest. WARREN'S MR. LUCKY settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out for room and steadied off heels into the stretch and was not a threat. CORNROW WALEASE chased inside, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally. KUYA sent inside to press the pace, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. SCONE veered out at the start, stalked three deep or off the rail, continued outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in and had little left in the drive.
