Footnotes

PIENSA SONANDO (CHI) angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch and closed gamely under left handed urging to get up late. FLEETSTREET DANCER pulled between horses early, saved ground stalking the leaders, came out leaving the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, took a short lead nearing midstretch, fought back through the final furlong and continued gamely to the end. NOSE THE TRADE (GB) a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, advanced inside into the stretch, altered course off heels past midstretch and surged late outside. DAUNTING three deep early, went up outside GENTLE GIANT to press the pace, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back between horses nearing midstretch and toward the inside in the final furlong and lost the show late. GENTLE GIANT sent inside to the early lead, dueled along the rail, fought back into the stretch but weakened some in the final furlong. DIG FOR IT four wide early, stalked between horses, came out into the stretch and weakened. EUCHRE four wide into the first turn, stalked three deep, also came out into the stretch and weakened. GREY MEMO unhurried along the inside, saved ground throughout and failed to menace.
