Footnotes

HIGHLY ARROGANT dueled three deep on the backstretch and into the turn, battled outside a rival on the bend, took a short lead between horses into the stretch, inched away and won clear under some urging and good handling late. SPIRIT OF WAILEA forced the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, split horses leaving the turn, came out in midstretch and just got the place. LOBSTERATHEPALMS bobbled slightly at the start, vied for command between horses on the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn, could not match the winner in the stretch and just lost second. BENIFLOWER stalked outside on the backstretch, went up four wide midway on the turn, came three deep into the stretch to loom a threat but was outfinished. FLYING BISCUIT also stalked the pace outside on the backstretch, continued three deep on the turn and lacked the needed rally. RIOMAIMAH chased inside on the backstretch and most of the turn, went around a rival into the stretch, angled back in and did not rally. DRAGONFLYER had good early speed off the rail then dueled inside, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
