**Footnotes**

ZOEMEG saved ground chasing the pace, came out in midstretch, rallied to the lead in deep stretch and proved best under a late tap of the whip and steady handling. EXCLUSIVE DANIELLE (GB) sped to the early lead, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, fought back in the stretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. MISSATACAMA (IRE) settled inside, came out on the second turn, split horses into the stretch, came out and gained the show. ROANAWAY BRIDE pulled her way along inside then pressed the pace between horses or outside the runner-up, fought back in the stretch but weakened late. KARLEE'S KITTEN prompted the pace three deep then briefly stalked off the rail on the backstretch, bid again three wide into the second turn, fell back some, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. ROYAL PRANA chased a bit off the rail then between foes leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOTALLY PHAT settled off the pace outside, chased three deep to the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. GOLD ON GOSSAMER chased outside then alongside a rival, was between foes into the second turn, dropped back and angled in on that turn and weakened.
