Footnotes

CHINA GRIND had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, gained a short advantage in late stretch, inched away under some urging and held. BATTLER BOB stalked the pace outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came out some for the stretch and finished well to just miss. CARSON CITY SLEW went up between horses then dueled on a short lead to deep stretch, fought back in the lane, weakened some late but held third. TRACEMARK saved ground chasing the leaders, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. IDE RATHER was slow into stride and settled outside, continued outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. HOT CONTEST settled a bit off the rail, split horses into the turn, angled out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. MISSED YOU chased between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. PRINCE DUMAANI unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came around a rival into the stretch and was not a factor. B. Z. JONES settled off the pace outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. EXTRA EFFORT close up between horses early then stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back along the inside on the turn and gave way. GLITTERBEND off a bit slowly, settled off the rail without early speed and was always outrun.
