Footnotes

STARRER close up outside stalking the early pace, bid three deep on the backstretch and briefly four wide on the second turn, challenged outside the runner-up into the stretch, put a head in front under urging inside the sixteenth pole and was inching away at the wire. QUEENIE BELLE saved ground stalking the leaders, slipped through along the rail on the second turn to gain the advantage, fought back inside the winner through a stiff drive but could not quite match that one late. TROPICAL LADY (BRZ) was in a good position chasing a bit off the rail, came out a bit leaving the turn, angled back in some and bested the rest. CEE DREAMS unhurried off the inside then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FEVERISH close up pressing the pace three deep on the first turn and between horses on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back leaving that bend, came out into the stretch and weakened. CRITIKOLA (ARG) allowed to settle off the inside, trailed to the stretch and failed to menace. MINOR DETAILS had good early speed between horses, set a pressured pace inside rivals, dropped back between foes on the second turn, regained the rail and weakened.
