Footnotes

SIPHONIC between horses early, stalked outside a rival, bid outside the leader on the second turn, put a head in front just past midway on that bend, then drew clear in the stretch under a couple cracks of the whip and good handling. FONZ'S four wide into the first turn, chased outside OFFICER, ranged up three deep into the stretch, could not match the winner but held second. OFFICER pulled a bit between horses and was shuffled slightly into the first turn, angled in and saved ground tracking the pace, went outside a rival on the second turn, angled out into the stretch and could not offer the needed late response. LABAMTA BABE sped to the lead three deep on the first turn, set a pressured pace outside a foe, battled inside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PUBLICATION unhurried off the rail then outside a rival, angled in leaving the second turn and was not a threat. YOUNGOTTAWANNA pulled his way along to force the pace inside, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. MOUNTAIN RAGE off a bit slowly, settled just off the inside and did not rally. BRIGADIER JONES (IRE) saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and failed to menace.
