Footnotes

STARRER angled in and pulled her way along to stalk the pace a bit off the rail, continued toward the inside on the backstretch, waited behind rivals leaving the second turn then got through along the fence into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, kicked away under urging and drew clear. CEE'S ELEGANCE prompted the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch, was no match for the winner but gamely held second. ANGEL GIFT close up four wide on the first turn, stalked outside, went four wide again with a bid on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and outfinished a rival for the show. SECRET OF MECCA pulled her way along inside to force the pace, steadied in a bit tight early on the backstretch, went up along the rail again and dueled on a short lead past midway on the backstretch and on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. POLAIRE (IRE) angled in and saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. NETHERLAND (ARG) dueled outside a rival or between horses, inched away a bit early on the backstretch and drifted in some, battled between horses, dropped back a bit three deep into the stretch, then drifted in and weakened.
