### Footnotes

DESERT GAL went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back along the rail in the stretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. ETCH sent between horses early, dueled outside the winner throughout and continued willingly but could not quite match that one late. LADY GENERAL chased outside then off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and gained the show. BUTTERTART stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, also came out into the stretch and outfinished for third. GO BYE BYE tracked the dueling leaders off the rail then a bit off the fence on the turn and weakened in the stretch. FUTURE THOUGHT chased off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a further response.
