WARREN'S GOLDIE stalked inside, came out into the stretch, took the lead alongside the pacesetter under a brisk hand ride past midstretch and won clear. RALPHY GIRL had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in the stretch, could not match the winner in the final sixteenth but held second. BABYNEEDSNEWSHOES angled in and dueled outside the runner-up, drifted out a bit in the stretch and bested the others. ANNALILI broke a bit slowly, settled just off the went around a rival nearing the stretch, came out into the lane and improved position. BULLETGIRL chased a bit off the rail then inside into and on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. TERRELLA stalked alongside the winner then off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. SWEET SOUL SISTER allowed to settle off the rail, angled in some on the turn and failed to menace.
