POINT GIVEN unhurried four wide into the first turn, went up three deep with a bid on the backstretch, vied for command through the second turn and into the stretch, lugged in a bit while putting a head in front past the eighth pole and inched away late under steady handling. MILLENNIUM WIND pulled his way to the early lead, dueled inside, came out a bit into the stretch, fought back gamely inside the winner but could not quite match that one late. GOLDEN TICKET also pulled a bit under a tight hold prompting the early pace outside the winner, continued between horses on the backstretch and second turn, angled inward in upper stretch, then came out some and weakened. BANK STREET three deep into the first turn, raced off the rail reserved under a hold chasing the leaders and also weakened in the stretch.
