PEANUT BUTTER MAN off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, split horses into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch, rallied to the front in midstretch and gamely held under urging. FUN AND SUN pulled inside early, split horses on the backstretch then moved up inside, came out leaving the second turn, bid inside the winner past midstretch but could not get by. R. F. BURTON sped between foes to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, kicked clear approaching the second turn, battled inside in midstretch then weakened but held third. SOUD angled in between horses then went outside a rival leaving the first turn to chase the pace, bid alongside the pacesetter into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. ALMUHATHIR hopped a bit at the start, settled just off the inside, came out on the second turn and did not rally. MARILYN'S VICTOR stalked three deep then off the rail, angled in on the second turn, steadied briefly off heels midway on that bend and weakened. JAKE THE GAMER was in a good position chasing three deep, fell back on the second turn and also weakened. IN DEEP had speed inside and stalked the pace along the rail, dropped back on the backstretch, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
