Footnotes

ASTONISHED (GB) came out and bumped with a rival at the start, dueled inside, inched away on the turn, kicked clear, drifted out some in the stretch but held on gamely under urging. SHADOW OF ILLINOIS had speed between horses then angled in leaving the backstretch to stalk the pace, continued along the rail and went willingly to the end to be second best. JUNGLE PRINCE bumped with the winner and was squeezed a bit at the start, stalked inside, came out in upper stretch and gained the show. LUCKY PULPIT forced the pace three deep then outside the winner leaving the backstretch, stalked off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. HONEAGLE chased off the rail then outside a rival, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. PINKHAIR (FR) off a bit slowly, settled out from the inside, angled to the rail on the turn and was not a threat. NIKINIPO (BRZ) four wide early, stalked outside on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the turn and weakened.
