Footnotes

FEAR THE BEARD chased outside a rival or just off the rail, went up three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, took the lead outside the pacesetter in midstretch and won clear under left handed urging. TIO VIC between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival into and on the second turn, came out in the stretch and gained the place. ES LUNA saved ground stalking the pace, continued inside into the stretch, came a bit off the rail late and held third. INQUISITIVE SON four wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival then off the rail leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SUPER CANDY saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the second turn and in the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LOCKHEART pulled a bit and angled in on the early lead, set the pace inside, fought back a bit off the rail in midstretch, was between foes in deep stretch and weakened. WARREN'S MARSHALL prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked just off the rail, continued between horses on the second turn and also weakened.
