Footnotes

DESIGNED FOR LUCK broke sharply but then settled off the leaders, advanced three wide around the turn, responded and challenged nearing the sixteenth marker, lugged inward, was straightened away and along in time while three deep. POPULAR YEAR prompted the early issue from the rail, remained inside into the lane, challenged and gained a slight advantage in the drive but could not stave off the winner. SEA COLONY set a pressured pace for the opening half, resisted when challenged in the drive and held on stubbornly between rivals to just miss. SMOKEYVILLE hesitated and was off very slowly, unhurried on the backstretch, raced a bit wide into the stretch but then found his best stride over the final eighth and closed furiously. SARATOGA AFFAIRS reserved early, angled to the rail and raced inside over the final three furlongs but failed to threaten. FLY TO MOSCOW forced the pace just outside the leader to the turn, dropped back around the bend and weakened. EL CHOLO reserved early, angled inward around the turn but lacked any late response. MARINE DRIVE void of early foot, remained well back into the stretch, was not perservered through the stretch and was eased late.
