Footnotes

OLIVER angled in on the first turn and stalked outside a rival, went up three deep on the second turn then bid alongside a rival, took the lead a quarter mile out, responded when briefly headed in the stretch to regain the lead past the eighth pole and gamely prevailed under urging. OH HOW NICE settled outside a rival then off the rail, went up four wide midway on the second turn and three deep into the stretch, briefly put a head in front alongside the winner in midstretch, fought back outside that one to the wire but was outgamed. SUPER HARMONY had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and just held third. SWINGIN JIM a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail, split rivals three deep on the second turn, was between horses into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. EGYPT (GB) was in a good position stalking the pace inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. GET OFF THE SUGAR pulled his way along and drifted out into the first turn, went up outside a rival to press the pace, steadied off heels midway on the second turn, dropped back between horses and also weakened. JUST HEAT stalked a bit off the rail or outside a rival, fell back on the second turn and gave way.
