MCKENZIES WAY angled in and dueled outside a rival then between horses on the turn and into the stretch, inched away in midstretch and held gamely under left handed urging. WALL DANCE broke a bit slowly, chased just off the rail, angled in on the turn, swung out into the stretch and finished with a rush. GENIUS stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep between horses on the turn and into the stretch and held third. HOPE AND BELIEVE bobbed at the start, angled in and dueled inside, fought back on the turn, lugged in, brushed the rail briefly and steadied nearing the eighth pole and was edged for the show. SLAMMER TIME stalked the leaders a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. KING OF CALIFORNIA off a bit slowly, went up outside to stalk the pace, bid four wide on the turn and into the stretch, drifted inward in the drive and weakened. MARKYG settled outside then off the rail leaving the turn, angled in some into the stretch and did not rally.
