Footnotes

CAPTAIN STEVE settled outside a rival, split horses on the backstretch, bid inside on the second turn, took command in the stretch and pulled clear while ducking in and drifting out in the final sixteenth. HIGH YIELD chased three deep on the first turn and backstretch, bid three wide on the second turn to take a short lead, dueled outside the winner, could not match that one in the stretch but was clearly second best. COSINE unseated the rider and ran loose briefly coming to the gate, went four wide on the first turn, angled in unhurried on the backstretch, advanced inside on the second turn and into the stretch and bested the others. CAMERON PASS saved ground chasing the leader to the second turn, came out on that bend and lacked a further response. PURELY COZZENE came off the rail on the first turn, chased between foes on the backstretch, steadied while beginning to weaken early on the second turn and gave way. MALABAR GOLD broke a bit slowly and awkwardly, pulled between rivals to the lead into the first turn, was rank on a clear lead and had little left upon reaching the second turn. .
