**Footnotes**

TELL NO TALES pulled early, angled in on the first turn and stalked a bit off the rail, bid inside on the second turn, took a short lead, inched away leaving the turn and won clear under some urging. THE BORG QUEEN chased off the rail, went four wide on the second turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for the place. LUCKY TURK allowed to settle outside a rival, angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued a bit off the rail in the stretch and was edged for second. WEHO unhurried along the inside early, moved up on the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch and just missed a minor award while between foes late. CONTINENTAL WINE sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace inside, battled between horses on the second turn, then weakened. BADINAGE bobbed at the start, had the inside rein break then bore out into the first turn, prompted the pace outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and also weakened.
