Footnotes

BENEFICIAL BARTOK stalked the pace inside, split horses past the eighth pole and rallied inside under some late urging to prevail. FLIRTY GIRL had good early speed and dueled between horses then outside a rival, regained the advantage three deep nearing midstretch and continued willingly but was edged late. BELVEDERE BELLE chased between horses, came out some in midstretch and edged rivals for third. BEND chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, steadied off heels in midstretch, came out and just missed the show. KYLIE broke slowly, pulled her way along off the rail then was in tight between foes into the turn, continued off the inside, swerved inward and was in tight again off heels in midstretch and could not quite summon the necessary late response. CUP OF COCO sent between horses early, dueled inside but a bit off the rail, angled in for the turn, fought back to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong, then returned bleeding in the mouth. CHERRY BOMBSHELL forced the pace outside then three deep leaving the backstretch, stalked between foes on the turn and weakened. JAZZNWITHCANDY pulled some and was in tight between horses early, stalked four wide leaving the backstretch and on the turn and also weakened in the stretch.
