JOHN THE MAITRE D pulled inside then a bit off the rail, came out three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. YES TALK TO ME had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch and saved the place. LONGANDWINDINGROAD chased outside then alongside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch and just missed second. ARE YOU POSITIVE prompted the pace between horses then stalked off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. JET STRIP BILLY chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed response. MIA COUNTESS sent along three deep to press the pace, dropped back on the turn and weakened. HOT ROD bobbled a bit at the start, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and was not a threat.
