Footnotes

STREETS OF HEAVEN hopped in a bit of a slow start, settled outside then off the rail, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes to gain the lead past midstretch, drifted in and held under urging. LARDOG chased outside then three deep, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch, gained the lead outside a rival in midstretch, was between foes past the eighth pole, also drifted in and held second. ORIENTATION HALL between foes early, angled in and chased inside, awaited room leaving the turn, got through inside in upper stretch, waited off heels again in midstretch, came out past the eighth pole and gained the show. WARRENS FLYIN HIGH stalked outside a rival then bid between foes on the backstretch, dueled inside, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. FRANKELSTEIN close up stalking the pace inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CARIBBEAN'S COMIC chased off the rail then between foes, continued alongside a rival leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. ATA BENCHMARK broke a bit slowly, trailed off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SCOTT'S SPIRIT sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail then dueled outside a rival, came out a bit between foes into the stretch and weakened. FUJI (IRE) broke slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out in the stretch and was outrun.
