FORTY DATES pulled her way between horses then chased off the rail, came out in upper stretch and rallied under some urging to gain the lead in late stretch and proved best. LOST PROPHET sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, inched away in the stretch and held on well but was overtaken late. SUANCES DE ESPANA a bit slow to begin, tugged her way up just off the rail then bid three deep into and on the turn and into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip just past the eighth pole and was edged for the place. SWEET AND JAZZY prompted the pace outside the runner-up then stalked between foes into the turn, continued off the rail on the bend, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. POPULAR DATE allowed to settle outside then alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and was outkicked. TOO PINK chased between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn and did not rally. SEARFAVORITSESECRET close up stalking the pace inside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. MOLLY MCFAST chased four wide then off the inside, continued alongside a rival on the turn and was not a threat. DESERT DEAREST a bit slow to begin, settled inside then just off the rail, came out in the stretch and was outrun.
