Footnotes

COMMA TO THE TOP stalked off the rail then bid alongside a rival to duel for the lead, took the advantage and inched away on the second turn, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and held. J P'S GUSTO stalked the pace inside, fell back on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and rallied willingly. CLUBHOUSE RIDE pulled between horses and steadied into the first turn, dropped back and angled in on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch and just got the show. GOURMET DINNER chased outside, went five wide into and on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was edged late for third. RIVETING REASON stalked three deep, continued between foes on the second turn, angled in leaving that turn and lacked a rally. RUSTLER HUSTLER was well placed stalking the pace between horses, fell back some on the second turn and weakened. SLAMMER TIME chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. RONIN DAX broke slowly, settled inside then came off the rail on the first turn, went outside a rival on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. INDUSTRY LEADER four wide into the first turn, chased outside, went four wide into and on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and weakened. HIGH LEVEL JEFF had good early speed off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, duelled on the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back nearing the stretch and gave way, then was eased in the stretch. The race was delayed about 25 minutes while COMMA TO THE TOP had a shoe repaired.
