RAUSCHENBERG a bit slow to begin, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and rallied under urging to get up three deep late. EL MIRAGE KING stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid alongside the leader past midstretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and was caught between foes late. HOWMUCHISIT had good early speed and dueled inside, put a head in front on the turn, inched away in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. BATTLE LOU stalked off the rail then outside a rival, continued between foes on the turn and alongside a foe nearing the stretch, came out in the drive and lacked the needed rally. INDUSTRY LEADER a bit slow to begin, settled off the pace inside, came out in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HIGH TEST chased outside, went three deep on the turn, angled in alongside a rival leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. MANDATED BLISS angled in and dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, fell back some in midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
