RUGGED RUGOSA sped between rivals to gain the lead outside a rival on the backstretch, shook clear into the stretch and proved clearly best under steady handling. CASH EXPRESS chased outside rivals on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and picked up the place late. MORN N' MIST broke out a bit, stalked the pace off the rail, then lacked the needed late kick but held third. SUPERGET sped to the early lead and the rail, pressed the pace inside the winner but weakened in the stretch. MELANCHOLY BABY settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival into and on the turn, came out for the stretch and lacked the needed rally. J VIVENDI saved ground throughout, went up inside into the turn, got through along the rail but lacked the necessary response. WHAT A SOCK dropped back early without speed, raced off the rail and was outrun. .
