TARHEEL WOMAN had good early speed and dueled inside on the backstretch and turn, inched away and came a bit off the rail leaving the turn, battled gamely outside POLISH WORDS while lugging in some in the final furlong and prevailed under urging. POLISH WORDS was a bit slow into stride, moved up steadily along the inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn, bid inside the winner in the stretch and continued willingly but could not get by. LORA AND I settled in the second flight three deep on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid outside the top pair. SIXSHOOTER was sent along to duel for the lead between rivals, dropped back a bit off the rail leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. CRAFTIQUE settled in midpack a bit off the rail to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. SHERRI SHINE angled in and vied for command three deep on the backstretch and turn, continued outside SIXSHOOTER leaving the bend and weakened in the stretch. MISS TERASITA between rivals early, dropped back off the rail on the backstretch and did not rally. BLAIR'S FAVORITE threw her head at the start and pulled between foes early, angled in some for the turn and lacked the necessary response. COOL ALICE settled in the second flight four wide on the backstretch, dropped back outside on the turn and weakened. LA RONGE sent between rivals early, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. .
