TIZ CHROME conceded early lead to rival, bided time outside that rival into bend, moved up, challenged three deep exiting the turn, surged to the front, came in some and accelerated away while shown the stick and hand pressure. DOMONATION reserved while slightly off the rail, angled out in upper stretch and gained the place while three deep at the wire. SHUDACUDAWUDYA settled outside, continued three then four wide to the stretch, came in some, between foes late and lost the place in final strides. CARDIFF GIANT angled over early, chased from along the rail, advanced inside pacesetter, gained brief lead passing quarter marker, could not match winner and lost placing nearing wire. CAMP VICTORY broke in bit but sped to the front, set pace while slightly off the rail, between foes exiting the turn, dropped back and weakened. PURSE LUYA forced in bit at the break, unhurried and lagged well back in early going, remained inside and was outrun.
