Footnotes

RAIL TRIP dueled three deep then stalked on the turn, re-bid outside the runner-up in the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch, was pushed along with hand urging to kick clear and was under a long hold late. GOLD STAR STATUS had good early speed and dueled inside, inched clear into the turn, fought back inside the winner in midstretch, was no match for that one in the final furlong and just held second. AGGIE ENGINEER was a bit slow into stride and squeezed some in the opening stride, angled in and chased inside, inched forward on the turn and waited momentarily off heels midway on the bend, came out in the stretch and just missed the place. BE REALISTIC (ARG) settled inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. WINK AT THE GIRLS dueled between horses then stalked between foes or outside a rival on the turn and weakened. BAD BIG AL allowed to settle outside then off the rail, dropped back on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and gave way.
